# **Inductive Bible Study Steps**

- 1. Prayer
- 2. Read the chapter
- 3. OBSERVATION

### Ask the 5 W's and H

- Who is speaking? Who is this about? Who are the main characters? To whom is he speaking?
- What is the subject or event covered in the chapter? What do you learn about the people, event, or teaching?
- When do/will the events occur or did/will something happen to someone in particular?
- Where did or will this happen? Where was it said?
- Why is something being said or mentioned? Why would/will this happen? Why at that time/to that person?
- How did/will this event happen? How did/will the people respond?
- 4. Mark key words and phrases.
- 5. Look for lists.
- 6. Watch for contrasts and comparisons
- 7. Note expressions of time (until, then, when, after, etc.).
- 8. Note terms of conclusion (wherefore, finally, for this reason, therefore, etc.).
- 9. Develop chapter themes. Don't rely on the ones in your Bible but know the chapter well enough to be able to summarize it in a short sentence.

# **Inductive Bible Study Steps (cont.)**

### 10. INTERPRETATION

- Context always takes precedence.
- Always seek the full counsel of the Word of God. Compare and contrast similar passages.
- Scripture will NEVER contradict Scripture.
- Don't base your interpretation on an obscure passage of Scripture taken out of context. (If the meaning of the passage is unclear then don't base your convictions on it).
- Take the Word of God at face value. Learn to recognize and understand figures of speech and literary styles.
- Look for what is clearly taught, don't try to twist Scripture to teach something that is not in that passage. Look for what the author is communicating.

### 11. APPLICATION

- Once we know what Scripture says, we have an obligation to accept that truth and live by it.
- What actions do you need to take now that you have a better understanding of Scripture?
